Licensing Aquatic Venues (216-RICR-50-05-4) Section 4.3.10 requires all licensed aquatic venues to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of the Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act, 15 U.S.C §§8001-8003 (VGBA). It is incumbent on the applicant who proposes to construct an aquatic venue to determine the appropriate components and to demonstrate compliance with the VGBA. In reviewing your application for the construction, the Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) will not evaluate the appropriateness of the presence or absence of VGBA components. Thus, in granting approval for the construction of the proposed aquatic venue, RIDOH in no way implies that the aquatic venue as designed and constructed satisfies the requirements of the VGBA. By signing this form, the applicant attests that all components listed below fully demonstrate compliance with the VGBA and were installed on the dates shown below:

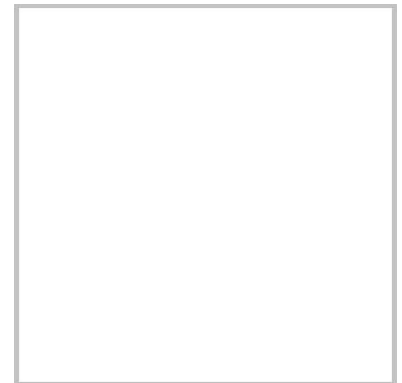
