

CONSENT ORDER

Michelle Caetano (hereinafter "Respondent") is licensed as a pharmacist pursuant to R.I. General Laws § 5-19.1-14 and holds license number RPH05170. On or about December 22, 2014, Respondent's license was summarily suspended in connection with an indictment against her in the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts. (United States v. Michelle Thomas a/k/a Michelle Caetano, C.A. 14-10363-R6S). Pending resolution of the charges against Respondent, the Rhode Island Department of Health and Respondent agree to the following:


1. The summary suspension of Respondent's pharmacy license is lifted;
2. Respondent's license is subject to the following restrictions:
 - a. Respondent may not compound drugs;
 - b. Respondent may not dispense drugs; and
 - c. Respondent may not make or manufacture sterile products.
3. Respondent must inform the Department of any changes to the above conditions of release or in her employment.

4. This agreement does not preclude the Department or the Rhode Island Board of Pharmacy from taking further action on Respondent's license when the matter is resolved or circumstances change.
