



Vaccines for Children (VFC) Eligibility Values Required for HL7 2.51 Implementation

Value	Description
V01	Not VFC eligible
V02	VFC eligible – Medicaid/ Medicaid Managed Care
V03	VFC eligible – Uninsured
V04	VFC eligible – American Indian/Alaska Native
V05	VFC eligible – Federally Qualified Health Center Patient (under-insured)

V01: Non VFC eligible – patients with private insurance

V02: VFC eligible – Medicaid and Medicaid Managed Care (RlteCare)

V03: VFC eligible uninsured – children have no health insurance and not enrolled in RlteCare

V04: VFC eligible American Indian/Alaska Native – if child born in R.I. this information is collected at Level 1 and entered into KIDSNET

V05: VFC eligible – Federally Qualified Health Center Patient (FQHC) **under-insured**. The under-insured patient is one who has insurance that does not cover vaccines. This patient must be referred to a FQHC to receive VFC vaccine

Q: What value do I use if a child qualifies for more than one VFC eligibility value?

A: Use the VFC value that will require the least out-of-pocket expense to the parent/guardian for the child to receive necessary immunizations.

Q: What value do I use if a child has private insurance and also has a VFC eligible value?

A: Use value V01 – not VFC eligible.
