### School Located Vaccination Clinics (SLV)

- Vaccinations are administered at school-based clinics from October through December
  - There is no out-of-pocket cost for the flu vaccine
  - Evening clinics are available to all community members ages 3 and older
  - The goal of SLV is to ensure that all Rhode Island children receive their annual flu vaccination
  - Immunization helps reduce school absenteeism and loss of work time for parents

### Summary of SLV Participation, 2017-2018

- 400 schools participated
- 247 individual and host clinics were held throughout the state
- Clinics were held from October 2 – December 12, 2017
- 25,932 children and adults were vaccinated in the program
